# Ornamental Blend Fertilizer

**All-Purpose Ornamental Blend**

Fertilizer for all vegetables and flowers including: tomatoes, carrots, beans, herbs, azaleas, roses, camellias, and pansies.

**Directions:**

**Vegetables:** Distribute 3-4 pounds per 100 square feet before spading garden. After spading, apply 2-3 pounds more per 100 square feet and work into the soil during final preparation. For row crops, make a trench 2 inches to the side of the seed row, 1 inch deeper than the seeds are to be planted and apply 1-2 pounds per 100 feet of row.

**Flowers:** Work 6 pounds per 100 square feet into soil before planting. Apply 2-3 pounds per 100 square feet every six months. Mix fertilizer into soil and water thoroughly after each application.

**Potted Plants:** A pot 6 inches in diameter requires 1 teaspoon of garden fertilizer monthly. For larger or smaller pots, observe same proportion. Mix garden fertilizer into the soil and water thoroughly.

**Window Boxes:** Every 2 months, work into soil 1 tablespoon for each square foot. Water thoroughly.

**Evergreens:** Feed evergreens in spring after danger of killing frost is past. Apply 3 pounds per 100 square feet in bed plantings. For individual plants, use 2 tablespoons for plants one foot high, up to one cup of fertilizer for plants 3 feet high. Place fertilizer under mulch around base of tree or shrub.

**Deciduous Trees:** Broadcast over area from tree trunk to ends of branches. Hasten growth of young trees by cultivating a few handfuls into the soil around the base of trees two to three times per year.
